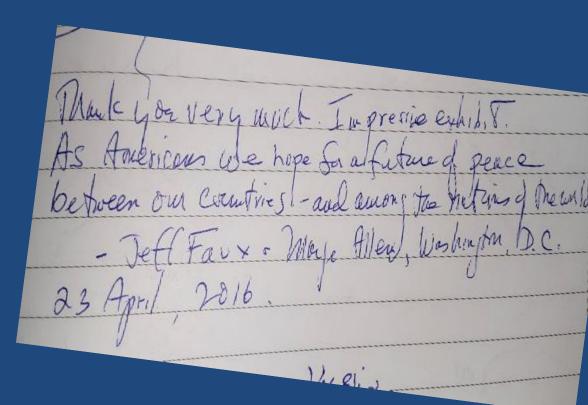
Visitors: Building Bridges

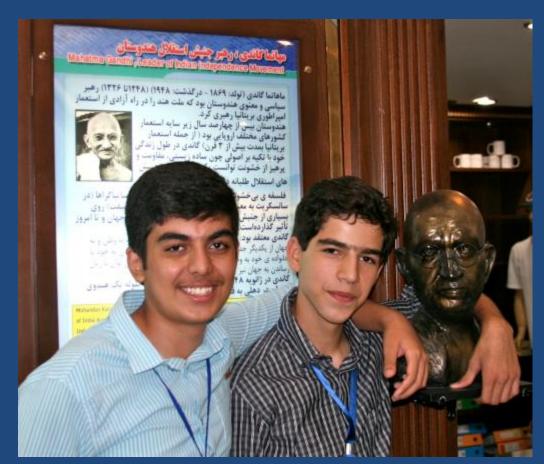

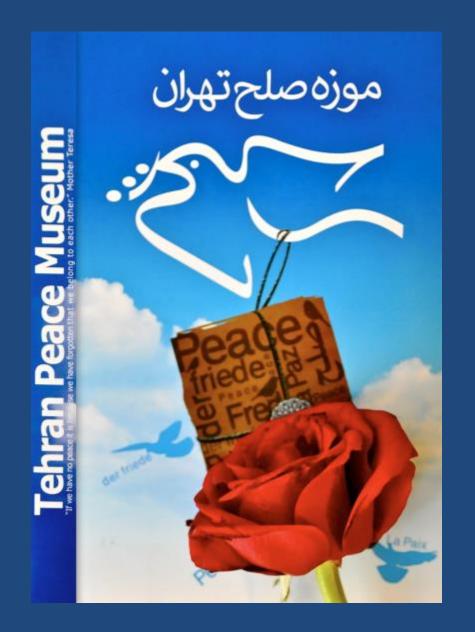
